**Resolution to Reduce Certain Speed Limits**

**Resolution #: 2015 -08**

**Whereas**, based on an engineering speed study and traffic investigation performed by the engineering firm of Morgan & Parmley dated September 9, 2015, the Town Board of the Town of Dovre, Barron County, Wisconsin, finds that it is in the public interest to lower the speed limit on a portion of 1<sup>st</sup> Ave., that being from 25-1/2 Street (Harelstad Rd.) to 29<sup>th</sup> Street (S. 5 Mile Rd.),

**Now Therefore**, the Town Board of the Town of Dovre, by this resolution, adopted on proper notice with a quorum present, by a majority vote of the Town Board present and voting resolves and orders as follows:

Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., the speed limit on 1st Ave., from 25-1/2 Street (Harelstad Rd.) to 29th Street (S. 5 Mile Rd.) is reduced by 10 miles per hour from 55 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour.


The effective date of this reduction in speed limit shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice of such speed limit have been erected and are in place.


The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations.


The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
